School is a busy place, especially before and after. Supervision will be available on the playground and in front of the school starting at 8:25. Doors open at 8:40 and students prepare for classes. Classes begin at 8:53. Late students should come in the main entrance and check in at the office. Please note the following morning and afternoon entrances/exits:

- Morning:
 - Grades K, 1 and 2 will enter through the SW door (by the gym)
 - Grades 3 - 6 will enter through the SE door
 - Junior high students will enter through the main entrance
- Afternoon:
 - Kindergarten will exit out the east door (beside the parking lot)
 - Grade 1 and 2 will exit out the main entrance
 - Grade 3-6 will exit through the SE door
 - Junior high students will exit through the main entrance

Drivers

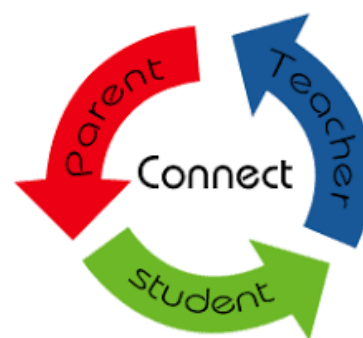

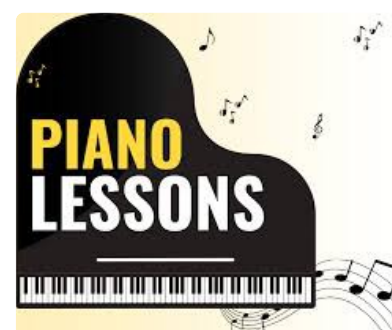
