Did you know that KPS has a care closet to support students with basic hygiene products and clothing items? Students or families can talk to any school staff if they need to access this resource.

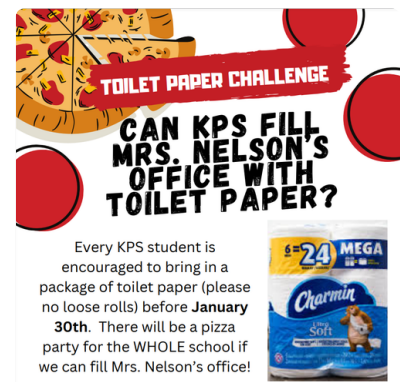

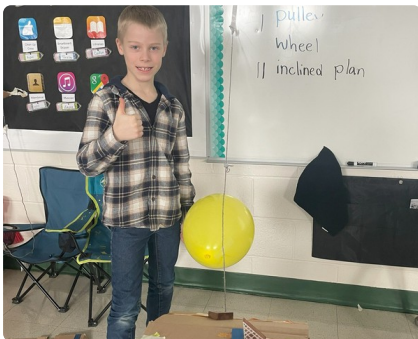

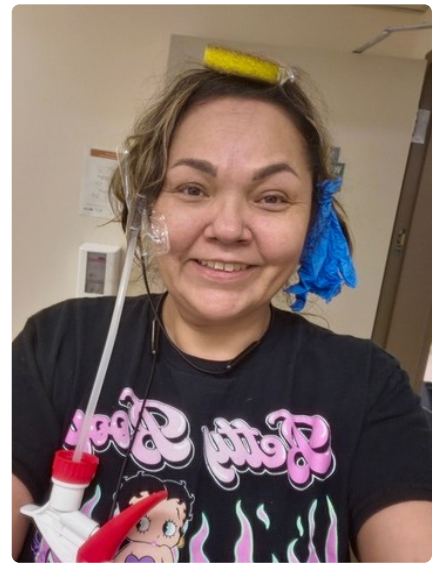
