Additionally, we ask that students continue to have outdoor shoes, particularly on wet and muddy days as this helps keep our school clean. Due to the risks associated with viewing the sun without adequate eye protection during an eclipse, BRSD has made the decision that all students will remain indoors from 11:40 a.m. to 1:40 p.m., unless picked up by a parent or guardian. Junior High students will not be allowed to go uptown on Monday, April 8 and should bring a packed lunch.




